Council has not yet confirmed the rates increase in the Long-Term Plan (LTP), we are therefore unable to advise the figures for the next three years.

Council is expected to adopt the LTP by 30 June 2025 and when that occurs - we can then confirm.

We are therefore required to refuse your request for information under Local Government Official Information & Meetings Act section 17 (d) *that the information requested is or will soon be publicly available*
