- Identify and manage significant risks early through proactive safety management.

- Promote open reporting of accidents, incidents, near misses, hazards, and health concerns by all workers, contractors, and visitors. We operate under a Just Culture, where honest mistakes and errors are treated as learning opportunities, not reasons for punishment.
- Provide enough resources — people, funding, equipment, and training — to ensure that all operations are carried out as safely as reasonably practicable.
- Monitor, measure, and continuously improve our safety performance.

At Westport Airport, safety is everyone's responsibility. We expect all workers, contractors, volunteers, and visitors to actively support a safe working environment and contribute to ongoing improvements.
