Refuse



Materials accepted as refuse



Household waste: general refuse, food scraps, green waste, general household furniture, timber.



Commercial and institutional waste

You can use any 60L rubbish bag to dispose of refuse, or bring it in your car, ute, truck or trailer for a fee.

The Reefton Transfer Station and Recycling Centre accepts a variety of additional waste types not accepted at the Maruia Landfill, including excavation material, construction/demolition waste, car tyres and bodies, gas bottles, used oil, whiteware, scrap metal, e-waste (electronic waste), batteries and agricultural containers.

Items that are not accepted for disposal

The site operator may be able to advise you about alternative disposal options that are not available at this facility.

- Tyres
- Car bodies
- Construction and demolition waste
- Fridges/whiteware
- Hardfill
- Gas bottles
- Aerosol cans
- Batteries
- Electronic waste (e-waste)
- Grease, fish or meat waste, carcasses
- Acids/alkalis and caustic waste
- Medical waste
- Explosive materials
- Sludges or biosolids
- Asbestos coatings
- Solvents
- Any poisons - as defined in the toxic substance regulations
- Caustic waste
- Any hazardous substances as defined in the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996
- Any other chemicals whether in liquid or powder form
- Agricultural/industrial products in sealed drums or otherwise.
- Glue, resin and bitumen products
- Mining waste

Recycling

Properly prepared recycling material can be dropped off for FREE at the Maruia Landfill and Recycling Facility.

The Maruia Landfill and Recycling Facility has a recycling container with four boxes, one for plastics, paper/cardboard and cans, and three for each colour of glass (clear, brown, green).



Materials accepted as recycling



Only clear and coloured plastics **#1, #2 and #5** are recyclable. **Plastic #1 meat trays** are now accepted. All items need to be rinsed clean, with any lids removed.



Cardboard and **paper** are recyclable. **Clean pizza boxes**, without food residue are now accepted. Items must be larger than an envelope, clean and flattened before going into your yellow bin.



Steel and aluminium tins and cans are recyclable. You need to rinse, clean, and check them.



Glass must be separated by colour: green, brown and clear.

Do not leave recycling material outside the container at any time. If the container is full, dispose of your recyclables at the Reefton Transfer Station and Recycling Centre during opening hours. Do not leave material next to the container or in surrounding areas.

Do not put broken glass, drinking glasses, windowpanes, car windscreens or mirrors in the container. They need to be disposed of as refuse at the Maruia Landfill or Reefton Transfer Station.
