Amount of debt should not be cosidered before testing assumed costs AND should not be considered unless combined with signed long-term contracts and committed forward work.in 2021 LTP even with revenue still at a loss. Spending nearly \$1m on equipment not needed for in-port work or committing to so much repair vessels value well beyond market value of vessel is risky.WMS buying vessel would aid port operation. RMC2 report (APril 2021) advised a more professional approacg needed to ensure success of dredging operation. Company using port to export commercially and globally betterplaced to own and operte dredger incentivised to keep operational costs at managable level. Port can then cncentrate on navigational safety, port access, berthage, wharfage and other fees. If keep ownership need confidence there is a need for the proposed debt, amount of debt makes sense and money not to be spent before work committments in place. Former crane and grab removed years ago would be useful in Port Nelson for logs and port detritus. Doubt DOP can do that -risky on too many levels.
