We refer to your official information request dated 14 December 2023. We wrote to you on 14 June to apologise for our oversight in not replying to your initial query.

The information you have requested is as follows:

- 1. Who first proposed the project The Town Plaza originates from the Westport "Design Framework Master Plan 2018" used to inform the Council-Led District Revitalisation Programme, first adopted by Council in the 2018-21 LTP. Stage 1 was completed in 2022 as the Town Precinct Pedestrian Plaza preliminary works to delineate an assembly space on Brougham St and provide safe connection across Adderley St. The Stage 2 proposal included further landscaping and streetscaping and improved amenity, however Council resolved in December 2023 to defer construction work until the next LTP cycle where it may be reconsidered.
- 2. What has been spent on it so far Stage 1 preliminary works costs were \$30k. Stage 2 planning and development costs before Council deferral are \$9.4k. Total amount spent from inception until 31 May 2024 is \$39.4k.
